RR DONNELLEY BOOSTS SUSTAINABILITY AND DATA SECURITY WITH NEW ON-SITE DOCUMENT DISPOSAL SYSTEM

New Facilities To Be Rolled Out As Part Of The Leading Outsource Provider's Environmental Strategy

LONDON – June 15, 2009. RR Donnelley's Global Document Solutions, a leading provider of outsourcing services for customer communications management, has embarked on an new environmental project that will further the company's commitment to sustainability, as well as pass added value to its clients.

RR Donnelley's Global Document Solutions, which handles millions of transactional mail documents every year, has just installed new waste disposal equipment at two of its four transactional print and mail handling sites in Barnwood and Tewkesbury, Gloucestershire. The new automated waste extraction system enables the company to recycle all waste paper securely without the need for a separate third party contractor.

Paul Davies, Technical Operations Director, said: "The nature of our print and mail service means that we generate recyclable waste on a daily basis. The removal and destruction of this waste was previously managed by an off-site third party contractor. As part of our continuous improvement programme, and in light of our practices designed to enhance data security and reduce the possibility of identity theft, we wanted to take greater control of this process. On-site shredding greatly reduces the risk of any documents containing sensitive data falling into the wrong hands."

Paul added: "This project is part of our environmental strategy, but also represents another way that we are offering added value and enhanced security to our clients."

The new waste disposal service, which is provided free of charge to GDS clients, shreds all waste paper into 10mm pieces before being automatically vacuum extracted to a central filter and compactor system. The new system is set to be rolled out across the company's other two UK transactional print and mail sites, in Milton Keynes and Gateshead, later this year – with similar plans in place for one of its high volume document scanning sites in Leicester.
